

ROUTINE

The author of Hebrews is speaking of Jesus' second coming when he speaks about the Day approaching. I'm going to use a little literary license and rewrite these verses to say: Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, NOT giving up meeting together, but encouraging one another all the more as SUNDAY approaches.

This month, as each week goes on and Sunday approaches, think of who has been missing from our pews and our fellowship. Give them a call or send them a note and SPUR them on and encourage them to come on back to worship! Help them get back into the routine of attending church and fellowshipping with each other!
